

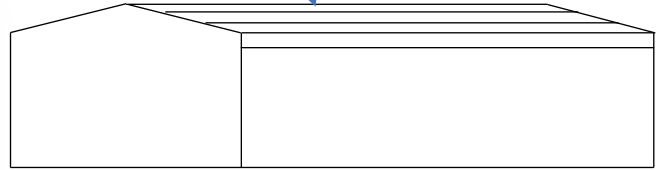
# ROOF STYLES

Note: the pictures are only meant to illustrate how each roof style looks in general, not to provide a detailed example of all the features of your building

## REGULAR STYLE, HORIZONTAL ROOF



HORIZONTAL ROOF



MOST ECONOMICAL. LOOKS MORE UTILITARIAN. RIBS OF ROOF PANELS ARE HORIZONTAL OR PARALLEL TO THE GROUND. WATER WILL RUN OFF THE FRONT AND/OR BACK. SOLID ITEMS (SNOW, LEAFS, ETC.) WILL NOT SHED OFF.

## A-FRAME STYLE, HORIZONTAL ROOF

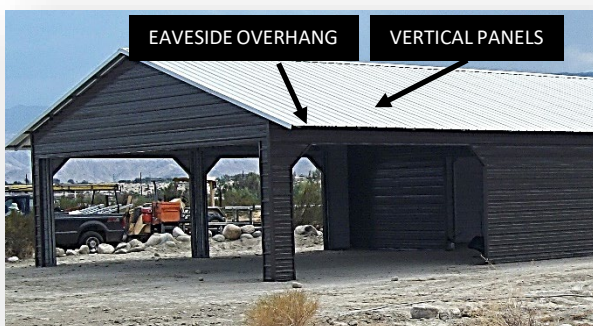


HORIZONTAL ROOF

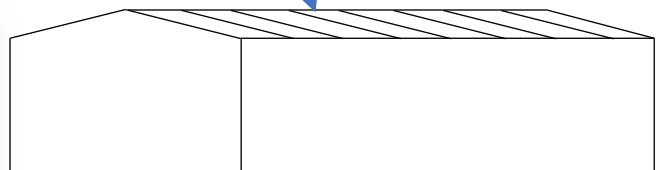


SLIGHTLY MORE COSTLY THAN REGULAR STYLE. CREATES AN EAVESIDE OVERHANG, WHICH MAKES IT LOOK MORE RESIDENTIAL. RIBS OF ROOF PANELS ARE HORIZONTAL OR PARALLEL TO THE GROUND. WATER WILL RUN OFF THE FRONT AND/OR BACK. SOLID ITEMS (SNOW, LEAFS, ETC.) WILL NOT SHED OFF.

## A-FRAME STYLE, VERTICAL ROOF



VERTICAL ROOF



MOST COSTLY. CREATES AN EAVESIDE OVERHANG, WHICH MAKES IT LOOK MORE RESIDENTIAL. RIBS OF ROOF PANELS ARE VERTICAL, GOING FROM THE PEAK TO THE EAVESIDES, THEREFORE ALLOWING ITEMS SUCH AS RAIN, SNOW AND LEAVES TO SHED OFF THE ROOF.
